

The Community Council has been alerted by Detective Constable Gareth Jordan from the Cyber Crime Unit at Dyfed Powys Police HQ, Carmarthen of a potential scam for you to be aware of.

The Police have been having a number of calls stating councillors are emailing or texting constituents asking for Gift Cards to be purchased. This is a scam. No Community Councillors would ask any constituents to do this on their behalf.
